Community Partnerships – 2022-2023

- 1. Silver Springs State Park
 - a. Seasonal decorations at the Park Entrance the Silver Springs Committee has been asked to decorate the fountain area at the entrance to the park for the holiday season. The Committee is working with the Park Rangers to plan and implement themed decorations for the Christmas holidays. All 4 circles will participate in the decorating each circle has an assigned area to complete. Poinsettias purchased from PGC by the concessionaire and the circles will be used to decorate the fountain along with hanging baskets of poinsettias throughout the park. This is a great support of the PGC Poinsettia Fundraiser and allows the members to support our partnership with Silver Springs State Park.
 - b. Florida Springs Festival March, 2023 PGC will have an educational booth with all 4 circles participating. A hands-on activity will be available for children and information about PGC and FFGC will be available to festival visitors.

 - b. Spring Event for youth if this event is held in the spring of 2023, PGC will participate.

 - b. PGC is planning to contribute to purchasing an art bench for the Art Park from fundraising events, President's projects and donations

 - d. Florida Arbor Day Celebration we will hold a Florida Arbor Day Celebration January 20, 2023
